
















Stickers By Artemio

The project consists on the literal translation of 12 common phrases from English to Spanish. These translations create new phrases with new meanings in Spanish. After that, these phrases were translated again from Spanish to the phonetically sound in Hindi. The phrases kept the meaning but the reading of them was only possible with the knowledge of Hindi. 2,000 rubber stamps of each Hindi phrases were made and distributed to the people to stamp the currency money of India. 250 millions of rupees were stamped and the people keep doing it every time a bill arrives to their hands.





#### Postmiseria

by artemio 2011 Lightning Installation Variable Dimensions

Presentation of a new concept in the contemporary art context.

Postmiserism verges on literary, artistic and cinematographic strategies associated to the assumption of a critical posture in light of demeaning social realities. Postmiserism refers to discursive constructs that pivot around sociopolitical and economic problems that degrade human existence, and which generally occur in peripheral areas. It touches upon the very narrow and delicate line that separates artistic practices with a political nature, and those that exploit misery by depicting it as exotic, and which are parasitic upon legitimate practices. On the other hand, postmiserism refers to the paradoxes of the artistic circuit, in the sense that objects, documents, interventions or actions are transformed into objects of patrimonial and/or commercial, luxury consumption, contradicting their foundational critical sense. Postmiserism also acts as a central pivot for certain academic and curatorial discourses which conceive our analyses of social, political, economic or human realms, not as a redeeming artistic practice, but as a frivolous level of expression.


**I Stay with You** starts out as an innocent comedy with rich girls having carefree fun. Gradually, however, the film undergoes a transformation, ending in dark sadism.

Artist Artemio Narro has made a number of installations and videos on the subject of violence. His first fiction feature is not only a commentary on the ever-present violence in Mexico, but also on how we see violence. The changing tone of the film and an ingenious turnaround in the battle of the sexes makes this film a confrontational experience.



ColOZio by artemio 2020

Feature Film 99"

In 1994, Mexican presidential candidate Colosio garnered attention for his democratic ideology and anti-corruption stance until he was shot through the head in Tijuana. The wondrous **ColOZio**, which is partly based on true events, starts three days prior with a prophecy to tripping friends Diego and Gael: save Colosio from death. The duo's dancing in a kaleidoscopic animated, almost 10 minute-long title sequence subsequently sets the tone for a playful, delightfully over-the-top road movie. Expect mythical apparitions, cartoony chases and plenty of drink and drugs.

**ColOZio** is Artemio Narro's second feature film. Whereas his debut **Me queudo contigo** (IFFR 2015) used horror conventions to comment on the omnipresent violence in Mexico, **ColOZio** is an idiosyncratic mix of adventurous odyssey and political reality.

Ultimately, as in every epic, the inner journey is crucial.

Blood is a conceptual project comprising more than 40 paintings. It is a selection of works that is as desirable as it is impossible, allowing us to trace a different path in the history of painting. This path is made up of traces of blood. Bringing these paintings together would be practically impossible for geographical, economic, political and logistical reasons. An exhibition like this is so unlikely that it is most feasible only in fiction or in this exhibition.
